 Oh Allah! I shall fast for Your sake, so forgive my future and past sins.

ALTERNATIVELY READ THIS DUA

بِصَوْمِ غَدٍ نَوَيْتُ مِنْ شَهْرِ رَمَضَانَ ۝

Bi-sawmi ghadin nawaiytu min shahri ramadhan

I intend to keep the fast for tomorrow in the month of Ramadhan.

### Dua for Breaking Fast

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُيَّمْتُ وَبِكَ آمَنْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ ۝

Allahumma laka sumtu wa bika aamantu wa 'ala rizq-ika aftartu

Oh Allah! I have fasted for You. In You I do believe and with Your provision (food) do I break my fast

### Zakat ul Fitr (Fitra) £4 per person

Before the end of the month of Ramadan. You must pay for yourself and can pay on behalf of dependents.

### The Three Ashras of Ramadhan

Ramadan is divided into 3 Ashras. Each Ashra is 10 days.

First Ashra (ten days) is for **Rahmat**: Mercy of Allah.

Second Ashra is for **Maghfirat**: Forgiveness of Allah.

Third Ashra is for **Nijaat**: Salvation.

### Lailat-ul Qadr

On this day the Holy Quran was sent down to the earth.

Hazrat Aisha stated that Prophet Muhammed PBUH said to "Look for Lailat-ul-Qadr in the odd nights of the last ten days of Ramadan." - Bukhari
